Please be guided with the following schedules and guidelines:

1. MATHEMATICAL OLYMPIAD - We are opening the invitation to all students to join the Qualifying Stage of The 20th Mathematical Olympiad this coming **October 28 (Sat), 1:00 PM at UP Diliman**. Registration for walk-in participants will start at around 11:00 AM, for a fee of only Php 150.00. Should your daughter be interested in joining this prestigious event, please have them sign up at the JHS Office on or before October 27, lunch time, since each school can only be represented by 30 students. 2. REVISED QUARTER 2 EXAMS SCHEDULE

Due to the special non-working holidays on November 13-15 and cancellation of classes on the 16th and 17th, the Junior High School unit be moving the Quarter 2 exams originally scheduled on November 23 & 24 to **November 27 (Mon) and 28 (Tues), 2017**. The subjects allotted for November 23 and 24 will also be the same for November 27 and 28, respectively. Kindly refer to Circular No. 48 for the said schedule. Modular Examination week will be on **Nov. 20 - 24**.

Since the exam days are on a Monday and a Tuesday, there will be no half day class anymore. We hope that your daughters would wisely make use of the week-long cancellation of classes to start studying for their exams.

3. CLASS STANDING NOTICE

For students who have failed in their unit tests and performance tasks, the class advisers will be issuing them with a class standing notice on **November 21, 2017**.

4. HALF DAY ON NOVEMBER 10 – The JHS faculty and administrators will be attending an Institutional Benedictine Formation seminar on Nov 10 (Fri), at 1:00 PM. With this, classes will have shortened periods and your daughters will be dismissed by 12:00 NN.

5. **MAKE UP CLASSES & JEEP (Grade 9) SCHEDULE** – Dates for the aforementioned activities will still be finalized. **The Pasyal Aral of Grade 8 will still push through on November 29 (Wed).**

6. **GUIDELINES for ASEAN SUMMIT WEEK**

With the 5-day class cancellation this coming November 13-17, and with the examination days on November 27 and 28, we hope that your daughters will take the opportunity to stay at home to be with the family, and enrich their learning by accomplishing take home tasks provided by their teachers. The following are details/ guidelines pertinent to these take home tasks:


- a. **Individual** reading assignments and **formative** assessments will be given beforehand, or sent online.


